

Tees Valley Skills Support for the Workforce 2019 – 2021

Skills Support for the Workforce in the Tees Valley is supporting eligible businesses to develop and implement bespoke, funded training plans to upskill their workforce, meeting immediate and long term skills needs.

The service provides tailored training programmes, fully funded by the European Social Funds for small to medium-sized business based in the Tees Valley LEP area.

The programme aims to upskill 3778 employed individuals from 1 April 2019 to 31 July 2021.

General Programme Aims:

- Provide support to employers to develop individuals to fill intermediate, technical and higher level skills gaps and shortages, tailored to the needs to the Tees Valley LEP area to stimulate a growth in the skills base.
- Provide a responsive service that will create opportunities for residents and businesses by aligning the service to economic priorities to strengthen the local economy.
- Provide individuals with opportunities to develop the skills that will enable them to progress in employment.
- Drive up skills levels, focusing on the skills being sought by employers and supporting the Tees Valley LEP's priority sectors.
- Upskill existing workforce to address replacement demand due to an ageing workforce particularly in senior and managerial roles.
- Develop vocational short courses to support employees to progress in work or to facilitate their access to higher level skills provision and apprenticeships.

Eligibility criteria

Employers must be:

- Small to Medium Sized up to 250 (headcount not FTE)
- Based in the Tees Valley LEP Area (based on postcode)
- Eligible for ESF funding (subject to the European Social Fund Programme for England 2014-2020 National Eligibility Rules).



Individuals supported must be:

- Aged 16 or over
- Employed in Tees Valley
- Eligible for ESF funding (subject to the European Social Fund Programme for England 2014-2020 National Eligibility Rules)
